SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On February 3, 1998, the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) issued an order that required the installation of new warning devices at the public crossing of the Fox Valley & Western Ltd. (FVW) tracks with Vinland Road in the Town of Oshkosh, Winnebago County by June 1, 1999. (crossing no. 179 805T)

Funding was unavailable to meet the deadline. The Commissioner has now assigned funding for this signal work in 2006.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED,

That the provisions of paragraph 1 of the order be amended to read:

1. That the **Fox Valley & Western Ltd.** shall install and maintain 12" LED automatic flashing lights with Type C circuitry and appropriate appurtenances in accordance with such plans as are filed with and approved by the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads at the crossing of its tracks with Vinland Road at-grade in the Town of Oshkosh, Winnebago County by **December 31, 2006**. (crossing no. 179 805T)
