SEE TRACKS? THINK TRAIN

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SLOW DOWN When approaching railroad tracks, always expect a train. Slow down, look both ways, and be ready to stop.

BE ALERT Watch for advance warning signs that indicate you are approaching a railroad crossing.

DITCH DISTRACTIONS Hang up your phone, remove earphones, turn down music, and don't text while driving or walking near tracks.

LOOK, LISTEN, & LIVE If you see a train coming, WAIT! The average freight train takes over a mile or more to stop.

DON'T GET TRAPPED, on tracks; proceed through a crossing only if you are sure you can completely clear it without stopping.
