NOTICE OF HEARING CANCELLATION  
AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Village of Pleasant Prairie previously filed a complaint regarding the condition of the crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Co. tracks with STH 31 (Green Bay Road) and the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads scheduled a hearing on that complaint on August 23, 2007. The railroad has commenced rebuilding the crossing and therefore the **hearing is cancelled and the matter is dismissed.**

By letter dated July 17, 2007, the Village of Pleasant Prairie filed a complaint with the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) under §86.12, Stats., that the Union Pacific Railroad Co. (UP) has failed to maintain in good condition for public travel the public crossing of its tracks with STH 31 (Green Bay Road) in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County.

Because the crossing is currently being rebuilt by the railroad there is no need to hold the hearing. Further, the object of the complaint has been fulfilled and the matter may therefore be **dismissed.**

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED,

That this matter is dismissed.
