Petition of Dodge County for a Determination of the Adequacy of Warning Devices at the Grade Crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Co. Tracks with CTH 'S' in the Town of Beaver Dam, Dodge County

AMENDED ORDER

Dodge County filed a petition with the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) for a determination under §195.28, Stats., of the adequacy of warning devices at the grade crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Co. (UP) tracks with CTH 'S' in the Town of Beaver Dam, Dodge County (Crossing No. 179 140A / MP 267.98).

An OCR investigator inspected the crossings in July 2006. No hearing was held.

On November 6, 2008, the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) issued an order that required that the Soo Line Railroad Co. install 12" LED automatic flashing lights with gates, and constant warning time at the crossing of its tracks with CTH 'S' in the Town of Beaver Dam, Dodge County by December 31, 2008.

A mistake was inadvertently made in the date of the deadline.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED,

1. That the **Union Pacific Railroad Co.** shall install and maintain 12" LED automatic flashing lights with gates, and constant warning time circuitry with appropriate appurtenances in accordance with such plans as are filed with and approved by the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads at the crossing of its tracks with CTH 'S' at-grade in the Town of Beaver Dam, Dodge County by **December 31, 2010** (Crossing No. 179 140A / MP 267.98).

2. That jurisdiction is retained.
