NOTICE OF STAY

On July 20, 2007, the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) issued an order that required the closure of the public crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Co. (UP) tracks with 20th Avenue in the Town of Strongs Prairie, Adams County after October 1, 2007 and before October 10, 2007 (crossing no. 179 265A). The Town of Strongs Prairie filed a petition for judicial review of this decision in Adams County circuit court.

The Town filed a motion to stay the OCR order pending the outcome of the court review. On August 29, 2007, the OCR consented to the stay of the order by its attorney Thomas J. Balistreri, Assistant Attorney General. The order for the closure is **stayed**.
