SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On November 2, 2000, the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) issued an order that required the installation of automatic flashing lights at the public crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Co. (UP or railroad) tracks with LaGrange Avenue (crossing no. 179 299U) in the City of Tomah, Monroe County by December 31, 2005.

After reviewing the crossing the Commissioner finds that the existing warning devices, which are crossbucks and stop signs, adequately protect and promote public safety. Therefore, the order for the installation of automatic flashing lights is rescinded.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED,

That the order for the installation of automatic flashing lights at the public crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Co. (UP or railroad) tracks with LaGrange Avenue (crossing no. 179 299U) in the City of Tomah, Monroe County is hereby **rescinded**.
